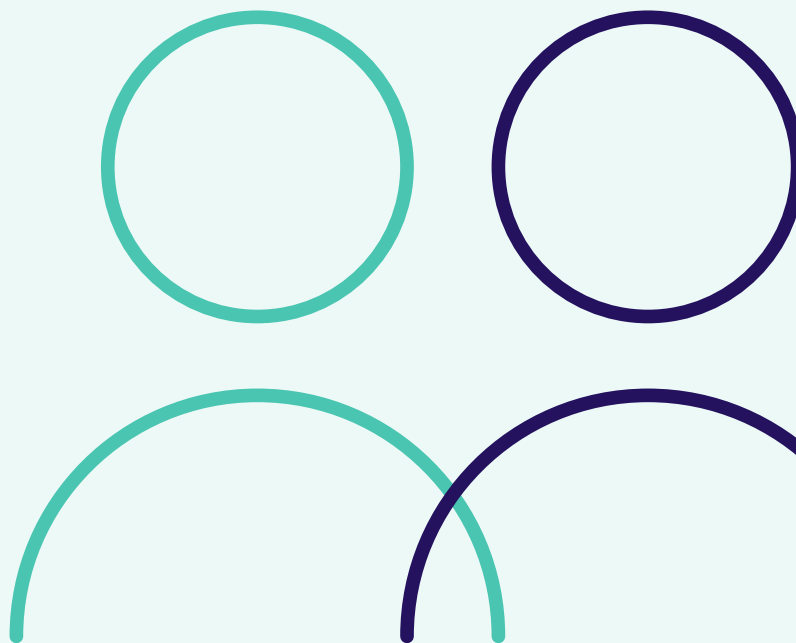

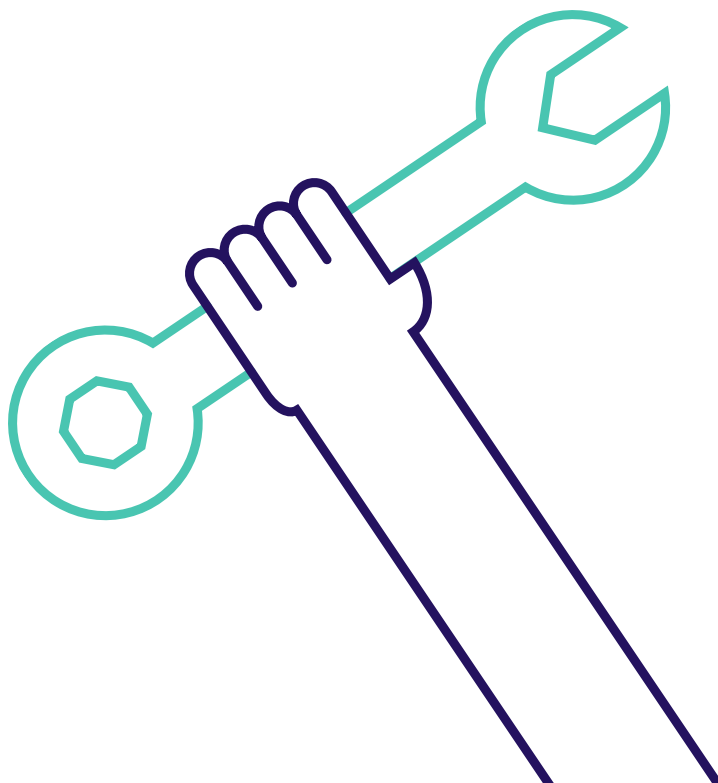

# T-Levels

**Technical Levels** are new courses that follow on from GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A levels.

These 2-year courses, launched in September 2020, have been developed in collaboration with employers and businesses to meet the industry's needs and prepare students for work, further training or study. A mandatory requirement is 'on the job experience, which must last at least 315 hours (approximately 45 days).

You will be tapping into a future talent with a genuine desire to work in your sector. Supporting T-Levels is an excellent opportunity to add diversity to your talent pipeline and help kick start a young person's career.

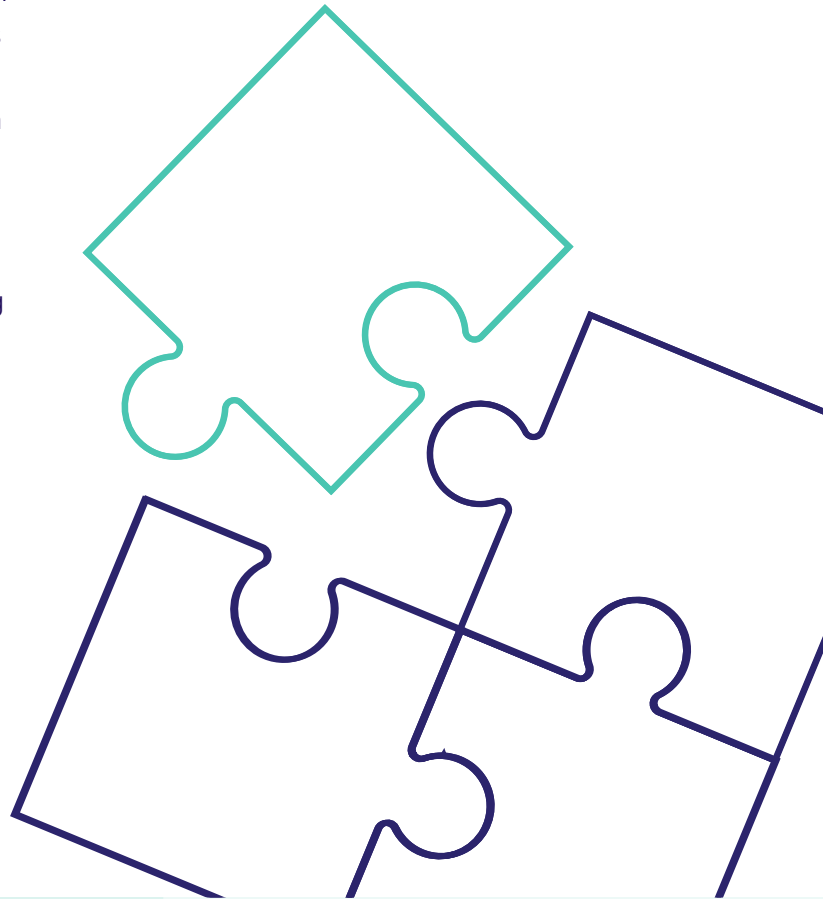

Once complete, send us your video and we will take care of the rest, professionally editing your clip before sharing on our various platforms.

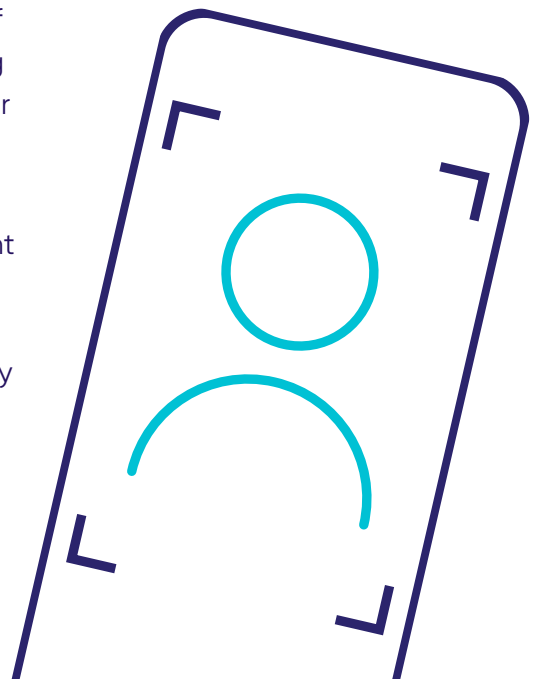

# Industry Insight Interview

The industry insight video is a pre-recorded interview hosted by Amos, one of our fantastic careers specialists. The interview is an insight into your journey and how you got where you are today.

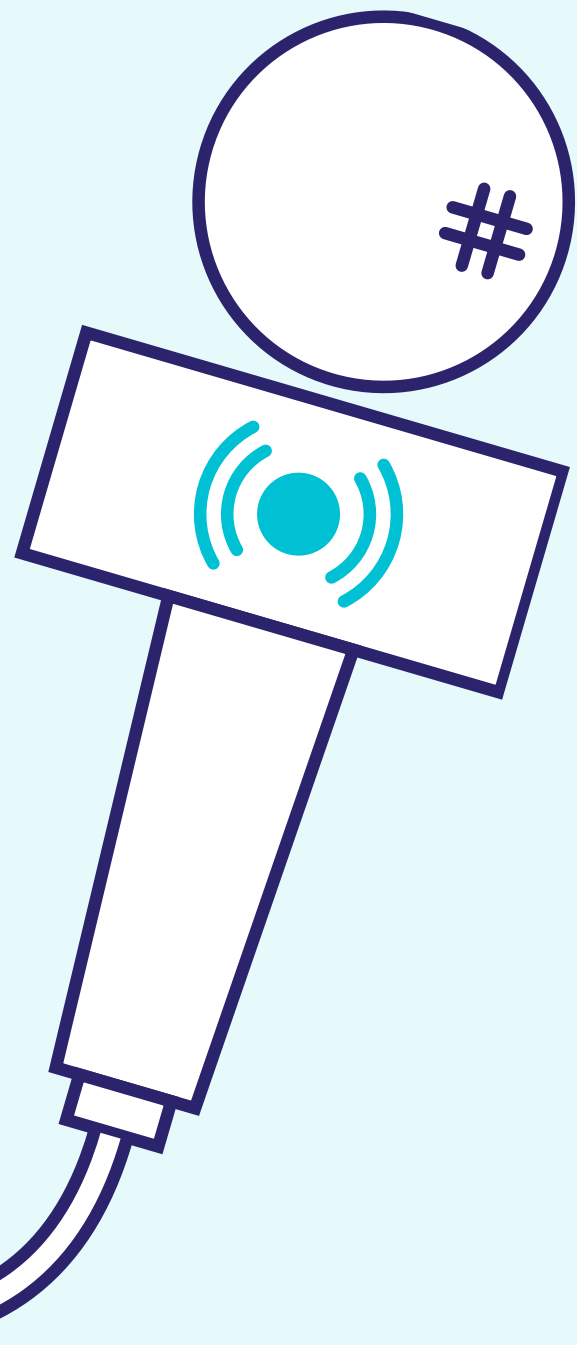
